Silla Caliente Rules

Silla Caliente: (1st quarter Spanish 1B; 2nd quarter Spanish 1A)

Last person in class sits on hot seat. Is in Spanish-only until they've answered the last question and gets up. Calls on 4 different people to ask the 4 ritual questions (Date, Time, Weather, Season). Asking a question that has already been asked results in payment to the previous asker. English results in payment to the other party.

Silla Caliente +: (3rd quarter Spanish 1A)

Last person in class sits on hot seat. Is in Spanish-only until they've answered the last question and gets up. Calls on 4 different people and asks them one of the 4 ritual questions. Each person in return asks a random question to the hot-seat participant. Asking a question that has already been asked results in payment to the previous asker. English results in payment to the other party.

Silla Caliente Especial: (4th quarter Spanish 1A)

Last person in class sits on hot seat. Is in Spanish-only for the rest of the period. Calls on each person in the class. Each person must ask a random question. Asking a question that has already been asked results in payment to the previous asker. English results in payment to the other party.

Silla Muy Caliente: (2nd quarter Spanish 1B)

Last person in class sits on hot seat. Is in Spanish-only for the rest of the period. Calls on 4 different people to ask the 4 ritual questions (Date, Time, Weather, Season).

Silla Más Caliente: (3rd quarter Spanish 1B)

Last person in class sits on hot seat. Is in Spanish-only for the rest of the period. Calls on 4 different people to ask the 4 ritual questions (Date, Time, Weather, Season). The 4th person asked then is in Spanish only the rest of the period. That person and the hot seat participant has a 2-minute conversation in Spanish. Everyone else fills out the Silla Más Caliente Weekly Report. If there is a pause of more than 3 seconds, the timer stops until they start speaking again. If they are able to go the whole time without a pause, they earn \$2. On Fridays, a random person is called on to try to Asking a question that has already been asked results in payment to the previous asker. English results in payment to the other party.

Thunderdome: (4th quarter Spanish 1B) Two different versions

Version 1: Last two students to show up. Answer the ritual questions. 2-minute conversation while others translate into journals. They return to their original group. They are my "go-to" people when others don't have the answer.

Version 2: Last student to show up infects his/her entire group. Group has a 2-minute conversation while others translate into journals.
